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Nature reserve of the Albufera & Paella Show cooking

Description: Guided visit to the nature reserve known as *Parque Natural de la Albufera* which is only 15 km South of Valencia. After a short drive we'll find ourselves surrounded by nature as the natural reserve comprises marshlands, woodlands, dunes and a lake. It has a high ecological value and in it there are species in danger of extinction. The marshlands contain some of the biggest rice-fields in Spain, while the lake known as *La Albufera* is a favourite stopover for migratory birds.

Panoramic drive on board the bus to *La Albufera* passing by the woods of *La Dehesa* and the rice fields. We arrive at the village of *El Palmar*, where we board our boats for our cruise on the placid lake and visit a *barraca* (traditional dwelling of the former fishermen and farmers of the area).

El Palmar is full of family-run and traditional restaurants where you'll be able to help and participate in the Paella cooking.

Paella lunch and return to Valencia.
